**Medication Assistance Program of Lincoln**

**Goal: To provide assistance to individuals unable to pay for their prescribed medications**

### Community Need

- According to the most recent US Census, it is estimated over 10% of Lincoln's population is uninsured.
- Many more have no healthcare prescription coverage.
- Many of these individuals are often faced with the choice to pay rent, buy food, or get their prescriptions filled.
- Community Impact – At the end of May, 2005, we have over 700 patients enrolled in our program, saving them approximately 2.5 million dollars annually

### Our Services

- **National Pharmaceutical Assistance Programs:** Most companies have FREE programs for individuals that make less than \$16,000 as a single person or \$25,000 as a married couple. We help clients enroll in these programs.
- **Discount Programs:** There are a growing number of discount programs available for certain medications.
- **Discounted Diabetic Supplies:** We provide very inexpensive diabetic supplies.

### Clients we serve

- 45 year-old father of three with hypertension working two minimum wage jobs
- 66 year-old widow living on \$800 a month with medications costing over \$1,000 a month
- 45 year-old diabetic who is disabled and on 15 different prescription medications
- 19 year-old with no health insurance going to school and working toward self-sufficiency
